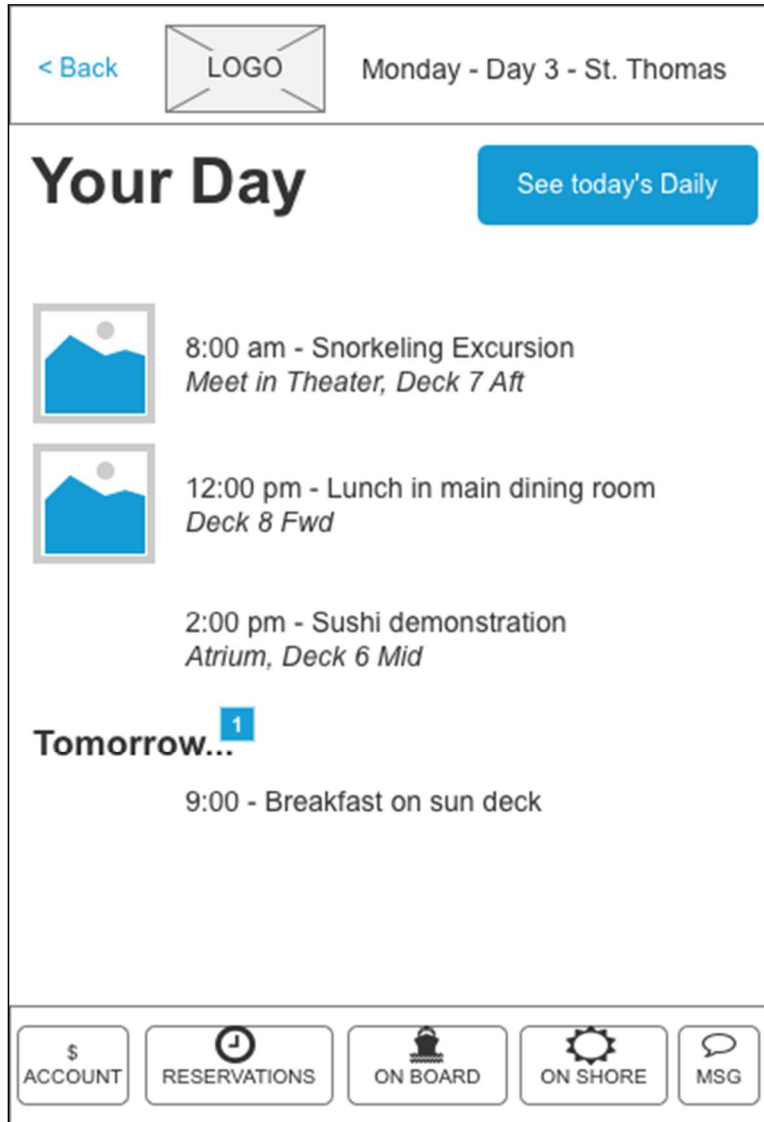


Your Day (Main screen)

This is the main, default screen for logged-in users. It displays any reservations or calendar events the user has scheduled for the current day. (Reservations have a photo associated; calendar events do not.)

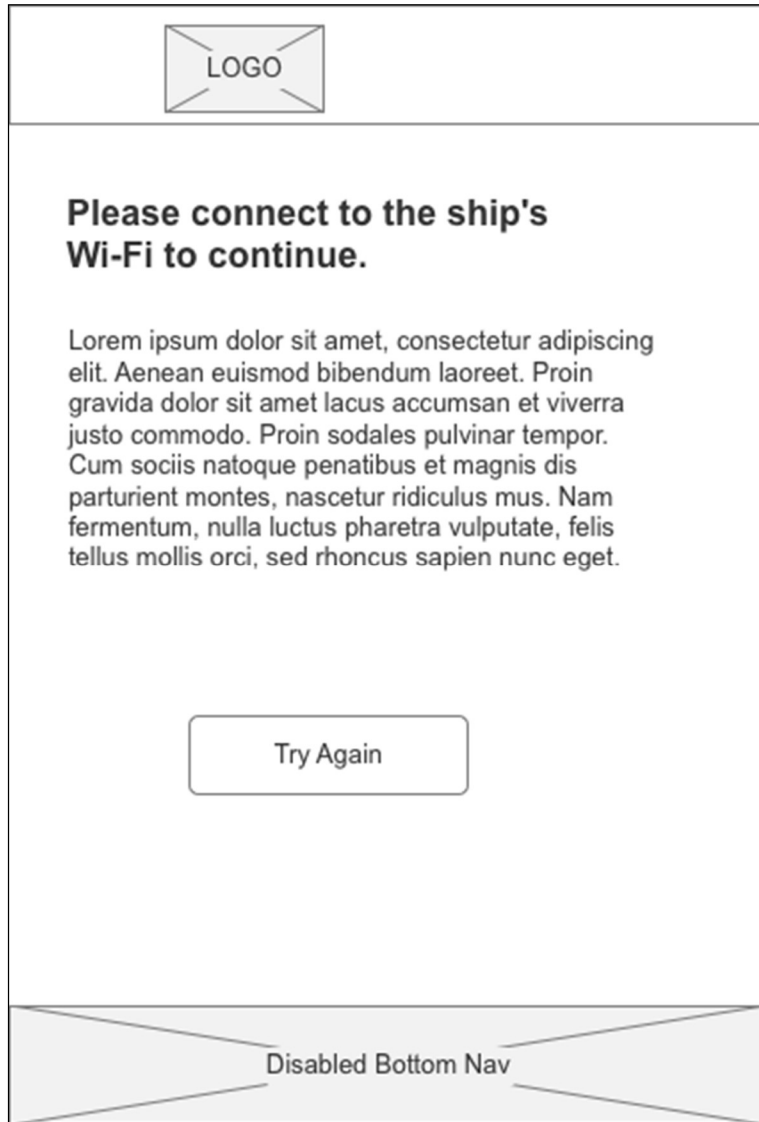

Not connected

If the user's device is not connected to a ship's Wi-Fi network, this screen appears. The user can be directed to find the appropriate network and proceed to either the login or main screen, depending on whether they are already logged in.



Login

Users are authenticated by entering their last name, room number, and date of birth. If these items match the records on the server they will be logged in and sent to the login page.

2	This field should use a mask to ensure the correct date format. Alternatively we could use a date picker; in this case we should only require month and date since changing the year can be tedious on some phones.

This is the general error state for form fields that use validation.

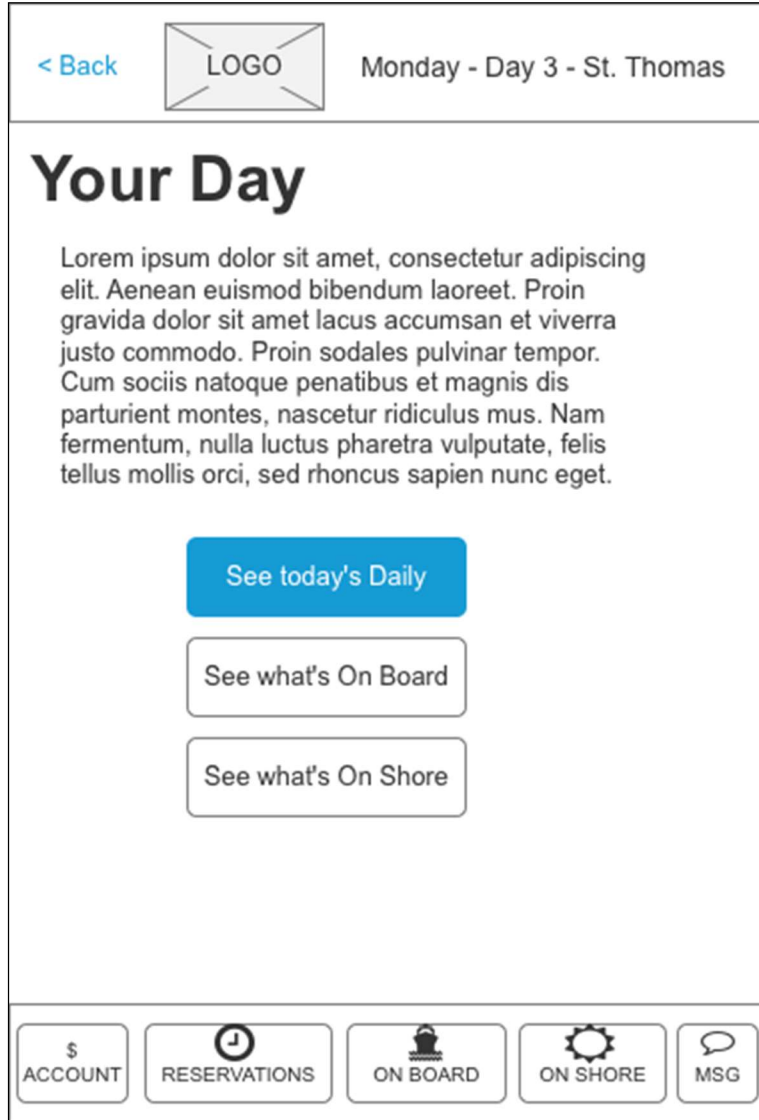

Your Day (Empty state)

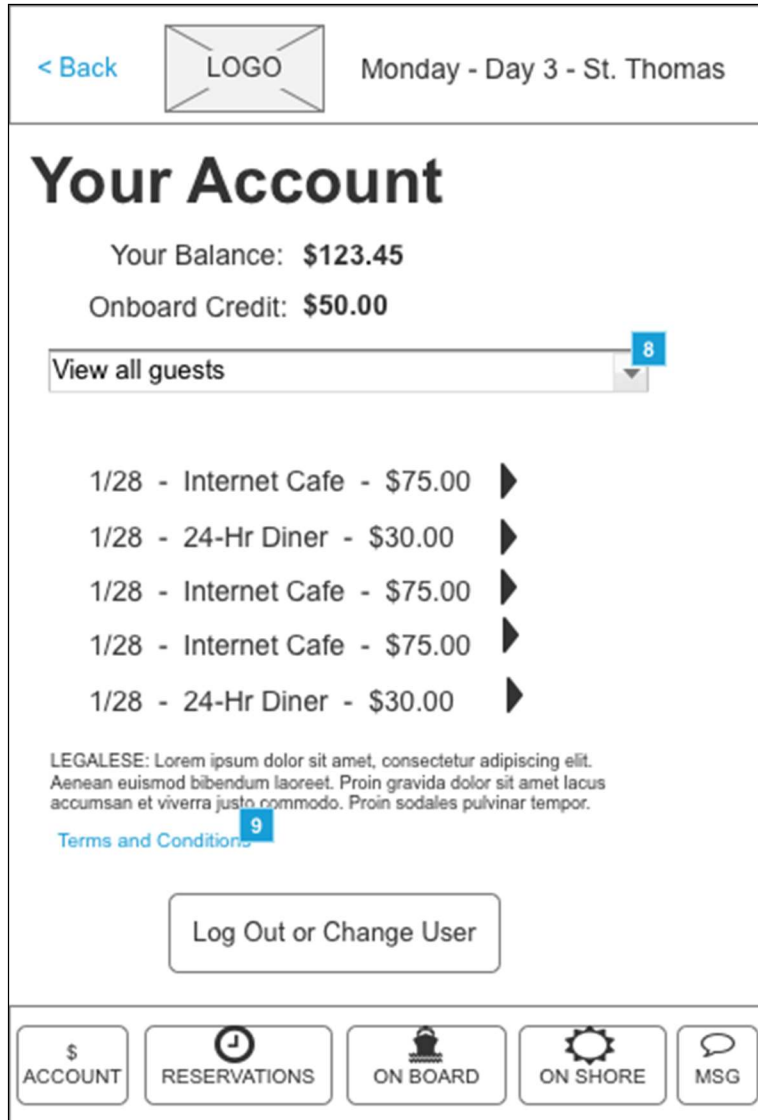

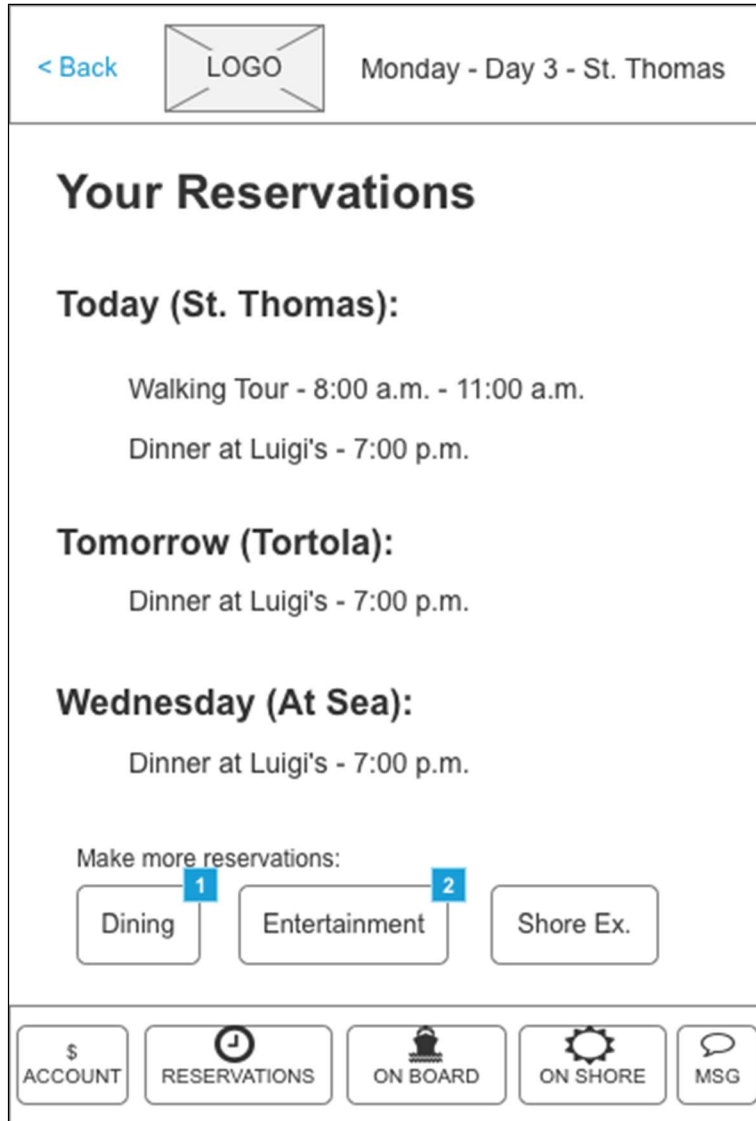

Reservations

Displays reservation the user has previously made.

One good future addition would be the ability to edit or cancel reservations; however, this does not exist in the current app and I get the sense the cruise line prefers not to deal with a lot of last-minute changes and cancellations, or they'd prefer users to visit a customer service desk to be assisted in person.

1	Goes to ship directory, filtered by Dining options.
2	Goes to ship directory, filtered by Entertainment options.

Reservation Detail

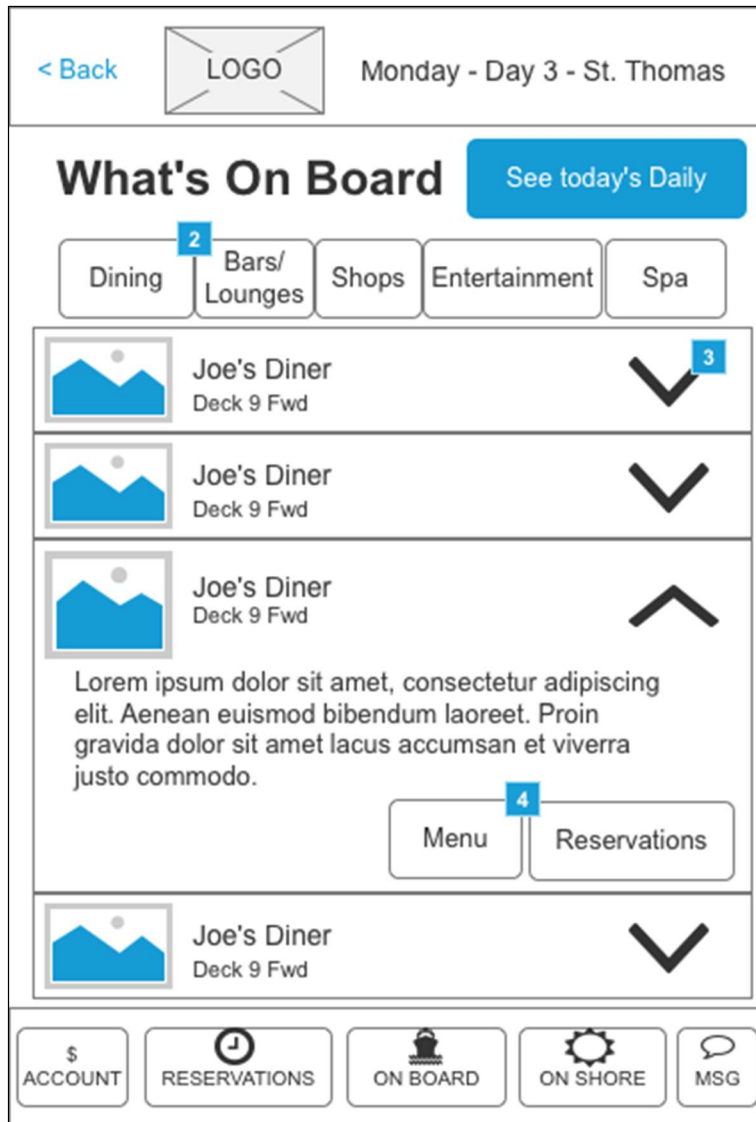

Footnote	Name	Note
3		Displays numbers ranging from 1 to the maximum number of persons allowed (may vary from one restaurant to the next).
4		Defaults to "Today", and lists any successive days.
5		Dynamically populated with available times based on party size and day selections.

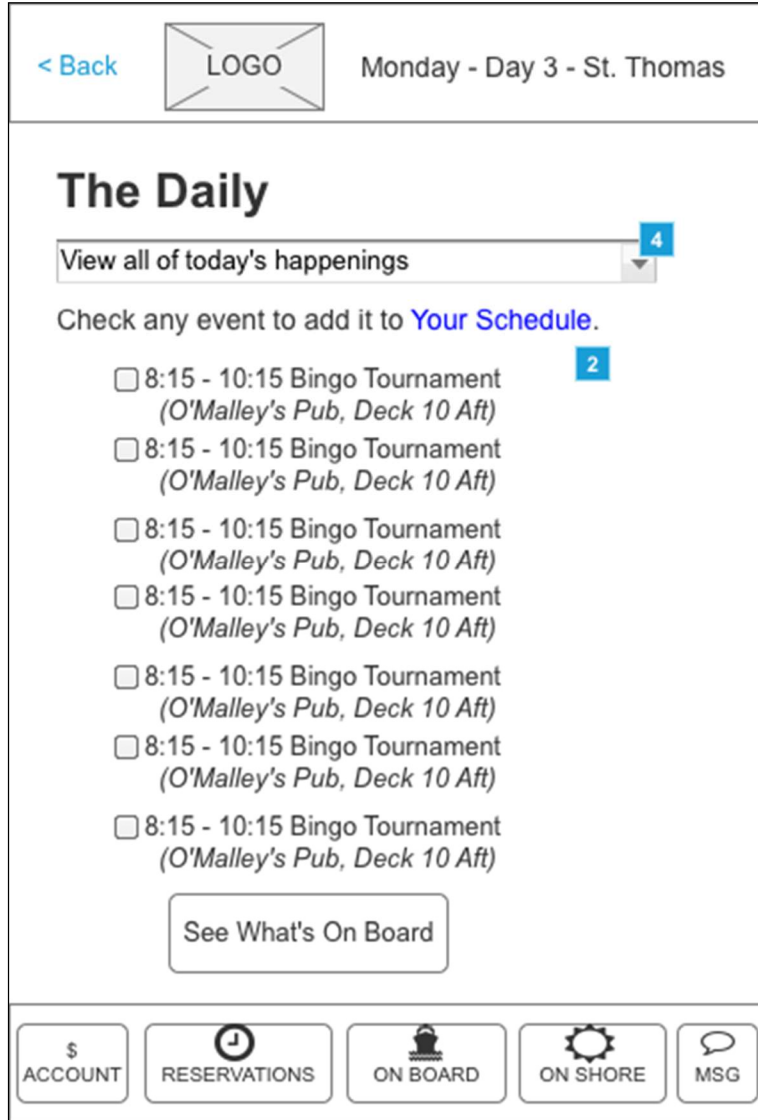

Footnote	Note
2	Category buttons can be toggled on and off to filter the list. If no buttons are selected, whole list displays. If one or more buttons are selected, only the items matching that category display.
3	On tap, accordion expands or collapses to show details.
4	Appears for restaurants and bars that have menus available. On tap, opens menu in a modal window.

Daily

The labelling and format of this page should echo the familiar printed "Daily" schedule that guests receive. In keeping with that metaphor, only today's events are shown.

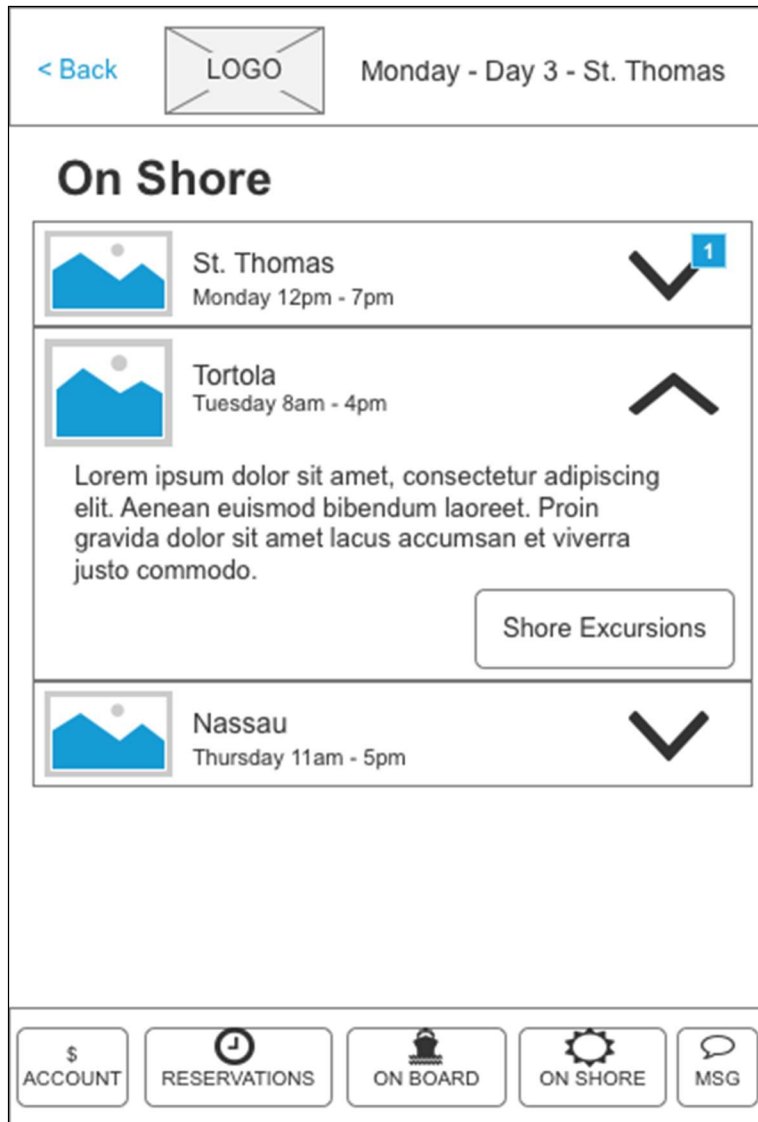

2	On check, calendar event is added to user's schedule. On uncheck, calendar event is removed.
4	On select, the event list is filtered by category.

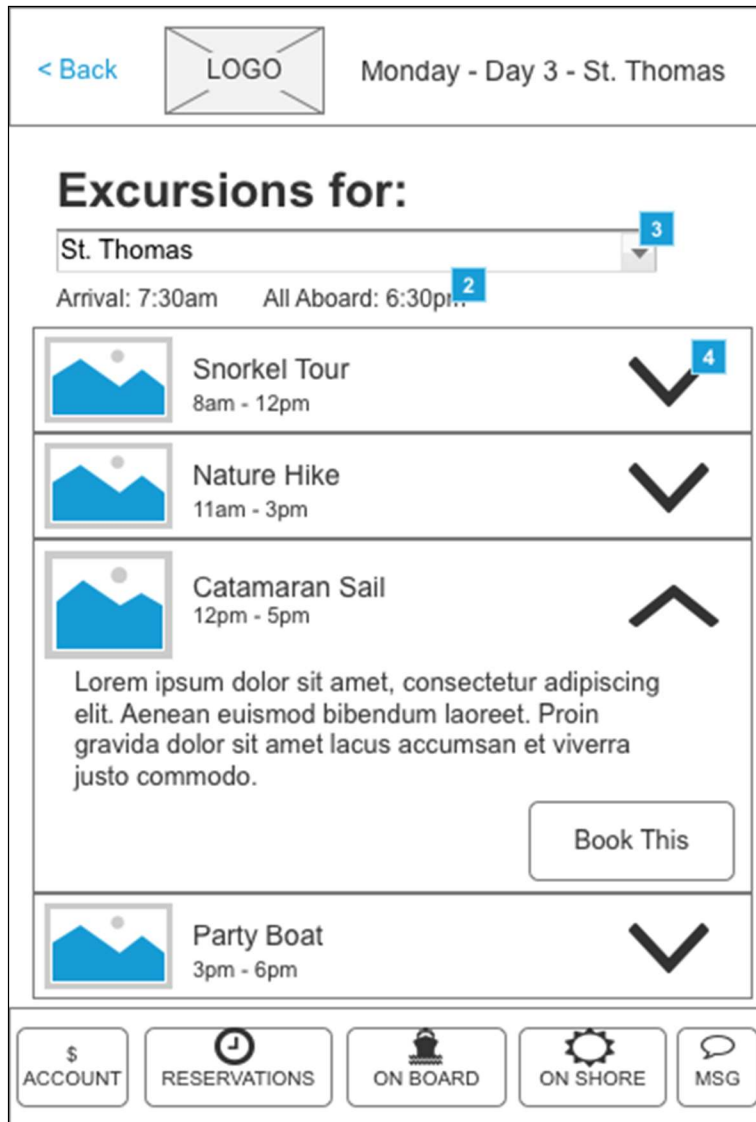

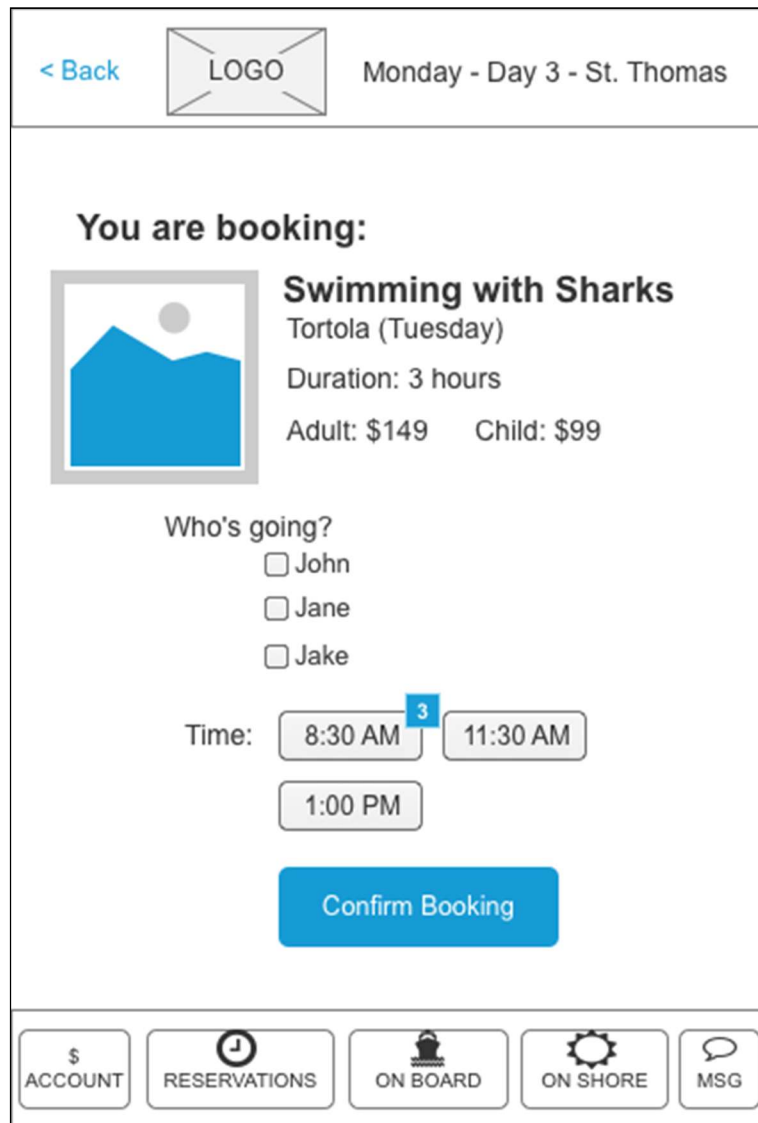

2	Text updates dynamically to reflect selection made in dropdown above.
3	Defaults to the next port. Previous ports are removed from the list since the user cannot schedule excursions for them.
4	On tap, accordion expands or collapses to show details.

Excursion Detail

To book an excursion, the user checks the names of the guests of their party and selects a time.

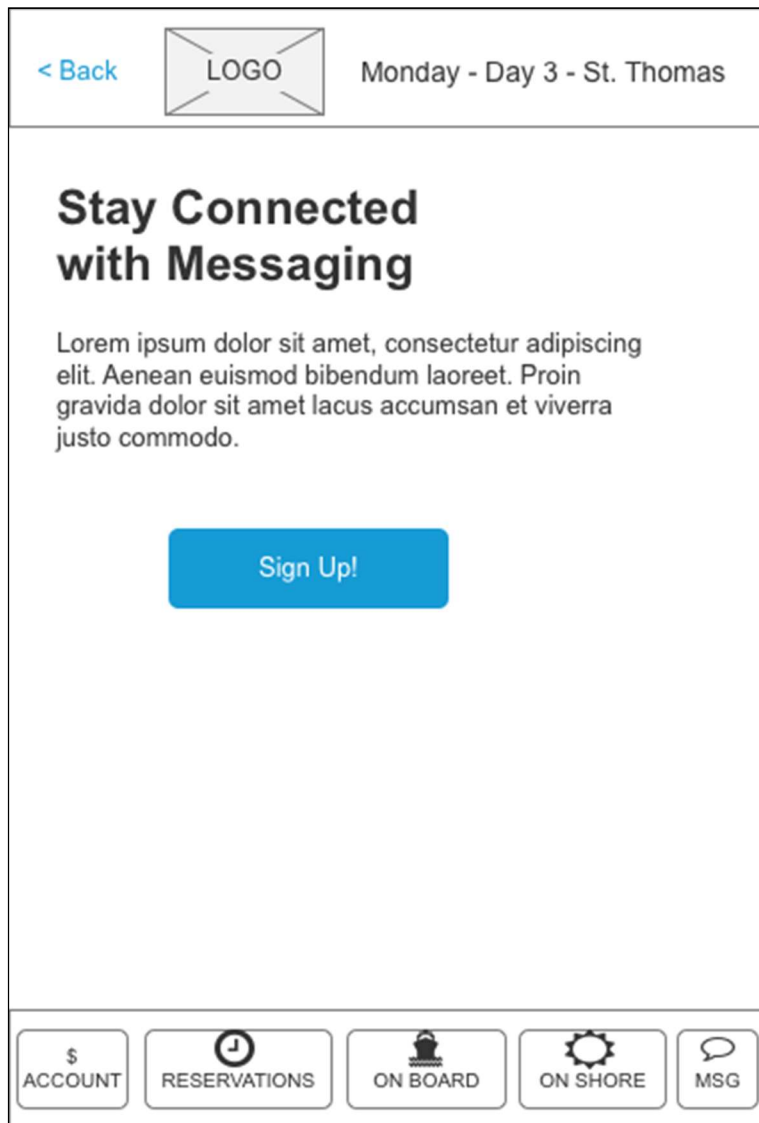

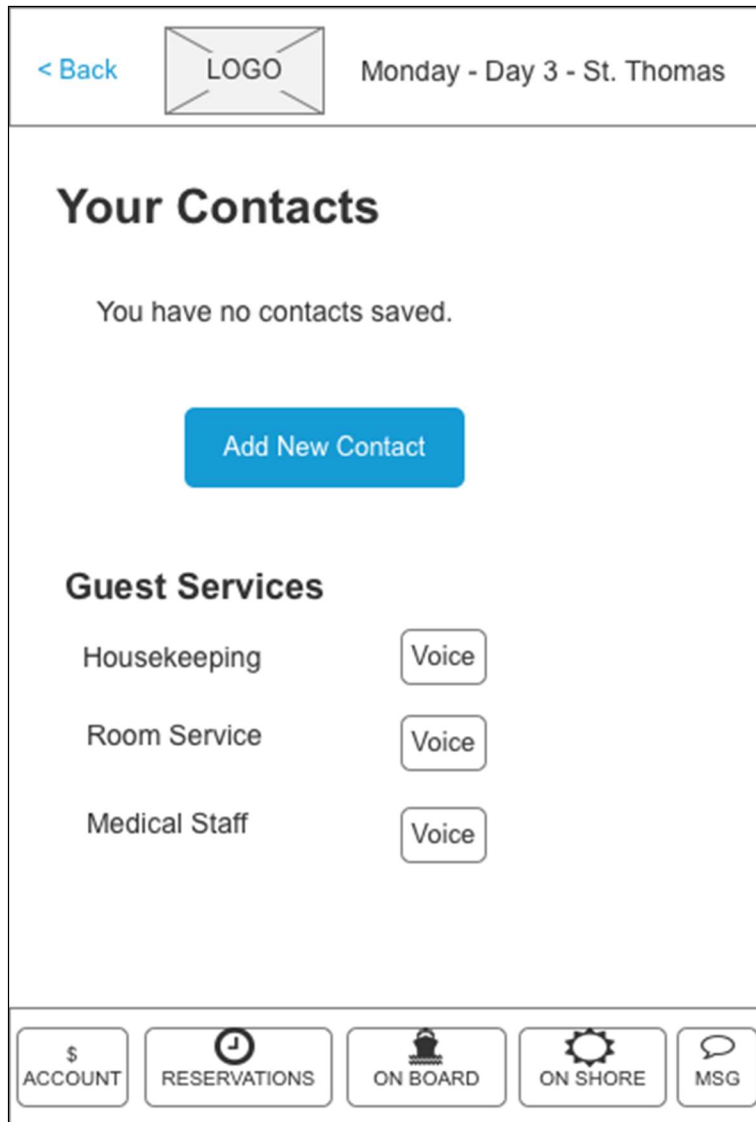

Your Contacts (Empty state)

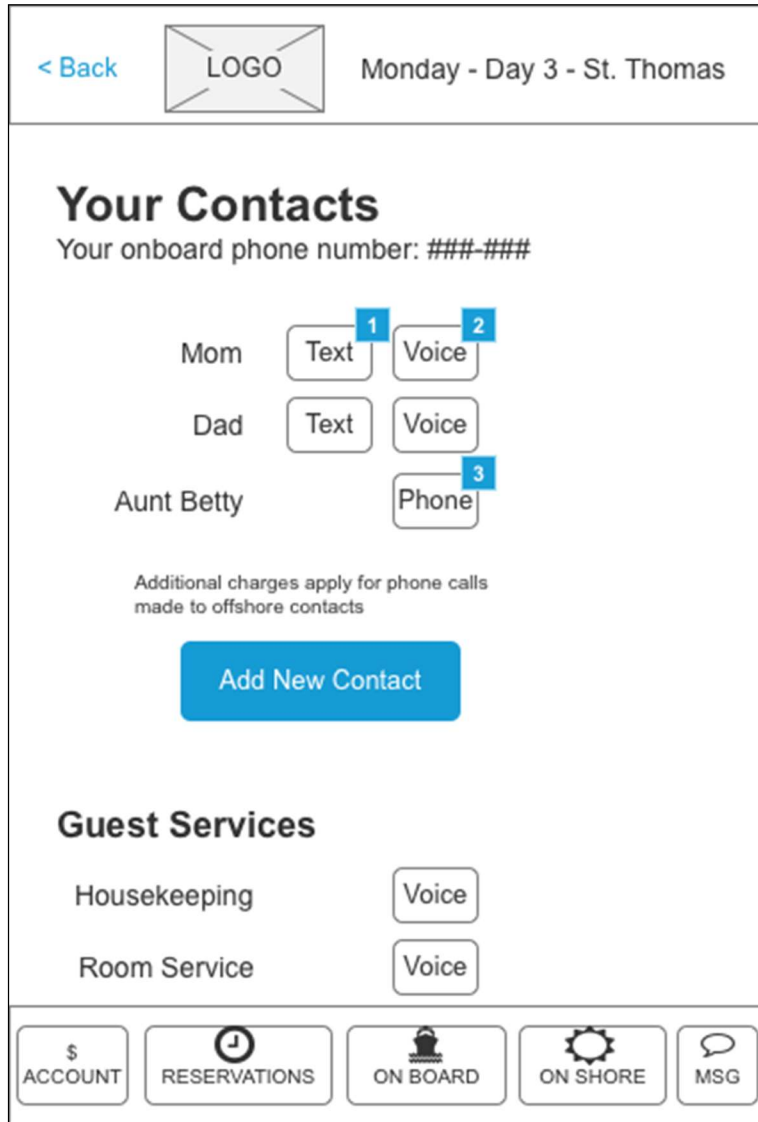
